Clothing

2 bathing suits
1 nice shirt or blouse
2 light weight pants/skirt – nylon preferred
2 shorts
3 t-shirts
Underwear - one week supply
Socks - one week supply
Sun/rain hat
Sweat shirt/sweater
Light weight jacket
Rain jacket/poncho
Sport sandals (TEVAs) or old tennis shoes
Trekking shoes or good tennis shoes
Extra shoe laces

First Aid Kit/Medication

Aspirin/Ibuprofen
Foot powder
Cortosone cream
Bandages
Insect repellent
Throat lozenges
First aid cream
Imodium/Pepto Bismal
Sun screen
Lip Screen
Medication
Motion sickness (Dramamine)
Vitamins

Toiletries

Typical stuff, use small bottles
(no stores available for 2 weeks)

Miscellaneous

Backpack - you will carry own luggage,
therefore convertible backpack is better.

Binoculars
Book light - flash light/batteries
Books
Business cards - optional
Camera equipment w/ min 1GB compact flash memory or film for 500 photos (Waved Albatross). 110 V available on boat and hotels for charging.
CD player/MP3 - optional
Credit card & debit card
Daypack - used for outings on islands to carry camera, water, guide book etc. Also used for airplane carry-on.
Ear plugs
Eyeglasses/contacts (extras)
Money - \$500 in small bills, 1's, 5's, 10's & 20's
Money belt worn inside clothing - no wallets or purses
Passport
Photocopies of passport & tickets
Plastic bags
Sunglasses
Swiss army knife (not in carry-on)
Watch (water resistant)

Snorkeling Equipment

Mask
Snorkel tube
Fins
Swim cap
